Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 77 residents and 45 staff members test positive for COVID-19. Our residents are continually monitored for any signs and symptoms of COVID-19 every shift while adhering to all CDC guidelines throughout our facility.

We are disappointed to report that a staff member tested positive during our weekly COVID-19 testing on 3/23/2021. As a result of this positive case, we have to put scheduled visitation on hold before we are cleared to resume. All indications point to this being an isolated case and we are cautiously optimistic that no other staff member or resident was affected. All staff and residents have been lab tested for COVID-19 as a precautionary measure and to ensure that the virus was not transmitted. As discouraging as this news is, please know that Julia Manor is taking every infection control precaution necessary to keep all of our residents and staff safe and once it is safe again to do so, we will resume our scheduled visitation.

WEEKLY UPDATE

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 77 residents and 44 staff members test positive for COVID-19. Our residents are continually monitored for any signs and symptoms of COVID-19 every shift while adhering to all CDC guidelines throughout our facility.

Due to our continued negative results and the positivity rate of Washington County now below the 10% threshold (9.7% as of 3/1/2021) via CMS, Julia Manor is excited to announce the return of scheduled indoor visitation! Please note that visits must be scheduled ahead of time. There will be a limit of 2 visitors per visit. Each visitor will need to provide verification of a COVID-19 negative test within 48 hours OR agree to have a rapid COVID-19 test performed prior to the visit at the facility. Please note that newly admitted residents who are within their 14-day observation period will need to transition off of the observation unit prior to scheduled visitation. We will be having visitation on 3 days each week: Tuesdays & Thursdays from 10 AM – 12 PM and 1 PM – 3 PM & Wednesdays from 1 PM to 5 PM. Each family will have a block of a half hour for a 20-minute visit and 10 minutes for staff to disinfect in between visit. Please plan to arrive 20 minutes before your scheduled time to allow for the rapid COVID-19 test to be administered as it takes 15 minutes for the results to be produced. Please contact our receptionist to schedule a visit at our main number (301-665-8700).

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering.
