Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. We currently have a total of 0 residents and 0 staff members with COVID-19 at our facility. We are working very hard to prevent the spread of infection and following all of the recommendations of our federal and local health officials.

Scheduled visitation continues as it has in previous weeks. Our visitation hours are from 10 AM to 12 PM and 1 PM to 3 PM on Tuesdays and Thursdays & from 1 PM to 5 PM on Wednesdays. Please contact our receptionist if you are looking to schedule a visit with your loved one. With the weather improving, we are happy to have your visits outside as well! A friendly reminder during visitation, please be mindful of COVID precautions during your visit. Family and friends must maintain 6 feet of social distance and remain masked at all times during the visit. We will be forced to end the visit prematurely if these rules are not followed as a safety precaution for not only your loved one, but for the health of all of our staff and residents as well.

We will also be having visitation on Mother's Day, May 9th! If you have not already done so, please call in and request either a morning or afternoon visit with your mother, grandmother, Godmother, etc. and we will be calling all families next week to let them know their specific time slot.
